



Creating an action plan to reach your personal goals, business goals, or organizational goals is the same process used for myPG to build a community wide plan for a great future for Prince George. A successful plan starts with clear goals for the future, then creates actions (or strategies) to reach those goals, and finally, the means to implement the actions and a way to measure progress toward achieving those goals.

The myPG story:



- 1. Goal Setting.** From October 26, 2009 to January 14, 2010, we listened to the community as community members provided their ideas on goals for the future of the community, and some ideas for actions to reach those goals. One thousand, nine hundred and seven people provided their goals and actions to myPG.
- 2. Developing Actions to Reach the Goals.** To create the actions required to reach the goals a series of workshops were held in February and March of 2010. Each workshop was attended by 35 to 45 representative stakeholder organizations and individuals with expertise or current experience in each focus area of sustainability (Environment, Social, Economic and Land Use) and specific workshops for youth, scenarios of external challenges, food security, etc.
- 3. Community Review of Goals and Actions.** Starting with a "Walk Through Open House" at the Pine Center Mall on March 27th, the community review of the myPG goals and actions will run until April 19th, 2010. Please help us review the draft myPG goals that you helped create, and the action we're proposing to achieve them. There are three parts to the review: review of the goals, review of the actions, and defining how you will know if we are making progress toward the goals.
- 4. myPG Plan Developed.** In June the revisions from the community review period will be completed, and the final draft of myPG will be presented back to the community. myPG is the first sustainability plan for Prince George. We are learning as we go and will continue to improve on our path to sustainability.
