“myPG Community Engagement Period Extended”

Prince George, BC- Due to a strong public response to participate in shaping the future of our community, myPG has extended the first community engagement period to January 14th, 2010. This will provide many organizations the opportunity to contribute their input after the holidays. Additionally, the extended engagement period will allow residents more time to submit critical information in developing myPG.

As part of the extended engagement, myPG will be conducting random prize draws from the surveys and workbooks that have been completed and entered online or returned to City Hall. All information submitted between October 26, 2009-January 14, 2010 are eligible to receive prize draws.

“Extending the community engagement period is very important in developing a shared community vision. The residents spoke and we listened, and this extension will generate more discussion and input to create myPG”, says City Councillor Debora Munoz.
